

George Michael – The Life 1963–2016

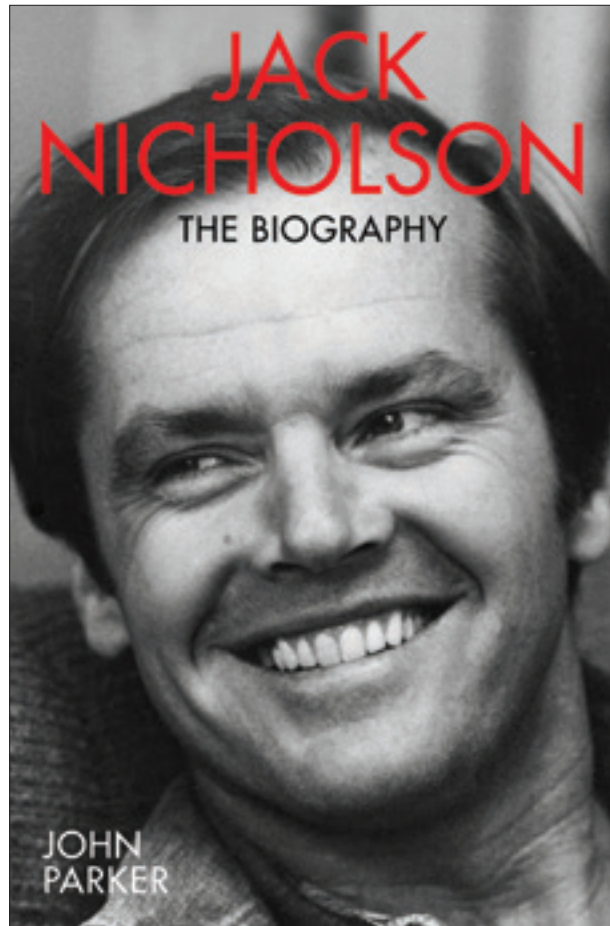

Born to Greek Cypriot immigrants in North London, George Michael dreamed of stardom even as a little boy. Aged just twelve, he met Andrew Ridgeley, and they went on to achieve stunning success in the early 1980s with Wham!.

Despite the enormous popularity of Wham!, however, George wanted more. Reinventing himself as a serious solo artist, he achieved even greater success. Yet even from the early days he was plagued with insecurity about his sexuality, which, with other personal tragedies, plunged him into a lifelong struggle with drug addiction. He died, at the tragically early age of fifty-three, on Christmas Day 2016.

George Michael's life and career made him one of the immortal greats of pop music, and his sudden death shocked the world. As Emily Herbert shows in this new biography, his legacy is not just his music, but his many extraordinary, often anonymous, acts of charity.

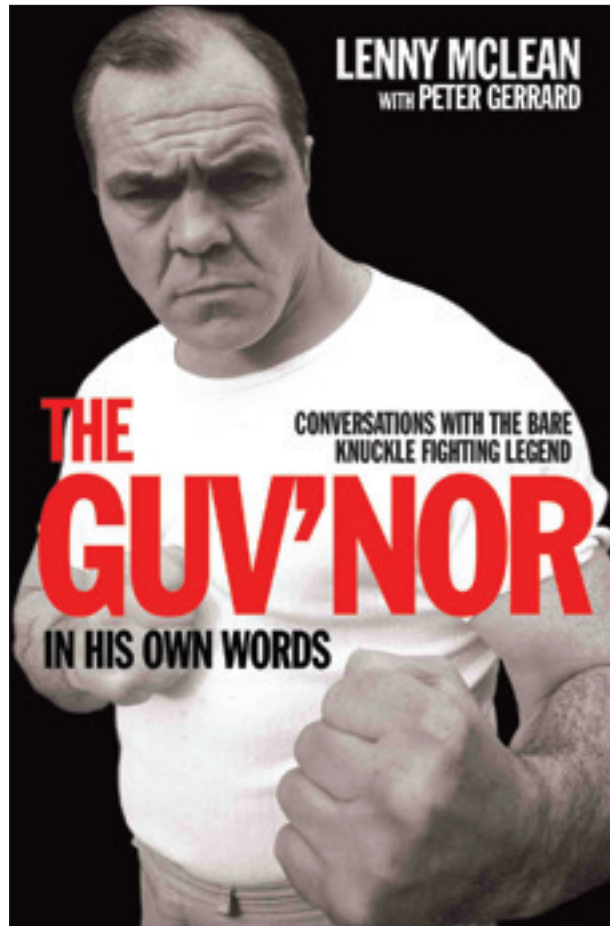


The Guv'nor

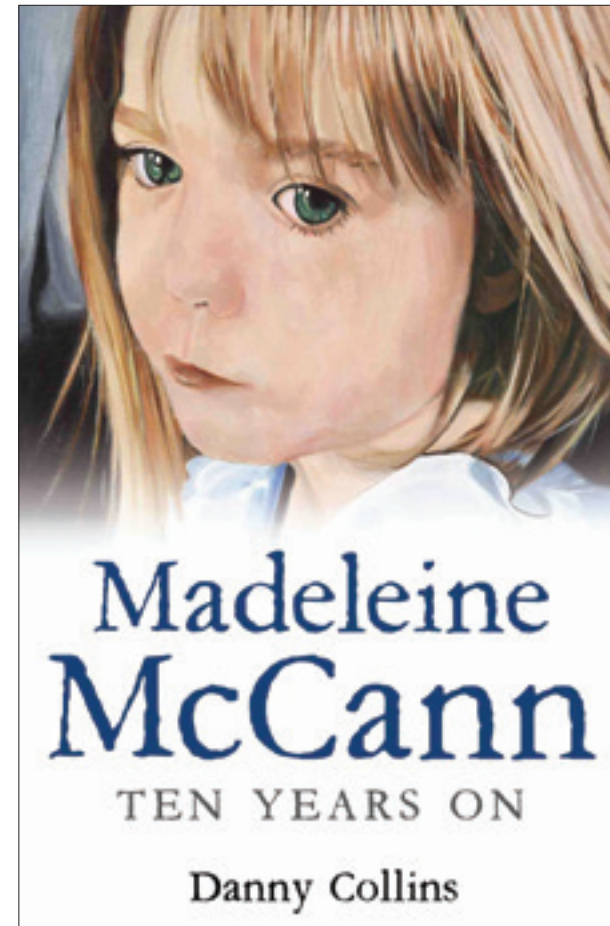
The Guv'nor in His Own Words

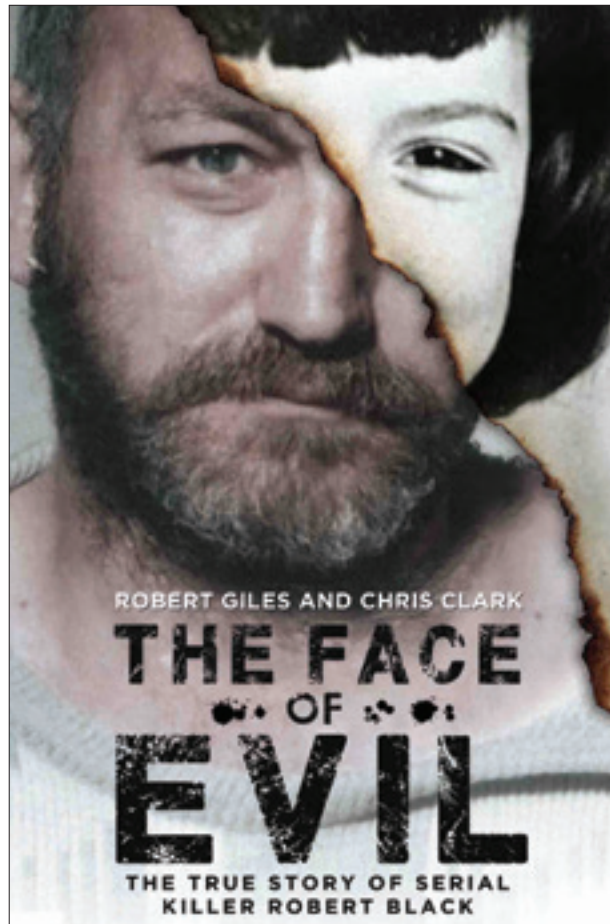

On the evening of 3 May 2007, Gerry and Kate McCann returned to their holiday apartment in the resort of Praia da Luz on Portugal's Algarve to every parents' worst nightmare: their daughter, three year-old Madeleine Beth McCann, had vanished from her room.

The weeks after her disappearance saw almost unparalleled levels of media coverage, as the face of a blonde, giggly little girl and her grief-stricken parents made front pages and news bulletins the world over.

Potential suspects were questioned and released – including Gerry and Kate McCann themselves. Opportunities were missed. Accusations were levelled on all sides. The competence of the Portuguese police came under scrutiny. Meanwhile, the international media asked why parents would leave their young children alone while they dined elsewhere.

Ten years on, Spain-based investigative journalist Danny Collins has returned to Praia da Luz to re-examine the case. This is the story of what happened on that terrible night and what has followed since.



The Face of Evil – The True Story of Serial Killer Robert Black

In 1994, Robert Black was convicted of the kidnap, sexual abuse and murder of four young girls, and sentenced to life imprisonment with a minimum tariff of thirty-five years. He died in HMP Maghaberry, Northern Ireland, in January 2016, aged sixty-eight, unmourned and unrepentant.

These horrific facts do not scratch the surface of the truth about this Scottish-born serial killer, who undoubtedly committed further murders for which he was never tried – both in this country and on the Continent. Robert Giles, who has spent years tracing the killer's movements and sifting through evidence, including transcripts of the trials, convincingly argues that Black was a long-term habitual killer. Co-written with Chris Clark, a former police intelligence officer whose tireless work into the Yorkshire Ripper case produced new evidence of other murders that went unnoticed or unrecorded, *The Face of Evil* paints a portrait of human cruelty at its worst.



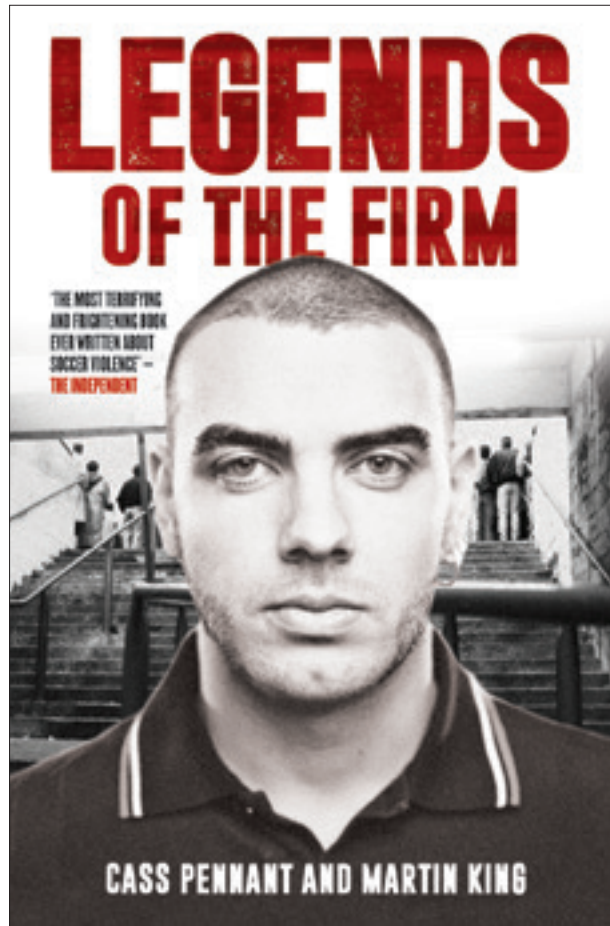
The Murder of Princess Diana – The Truth Behind the Assassination of the People's Princess

For almost ten years, he fell prey to a rampant cocaine habit, making him unpredictable and dangerous to be around. Out of sheer desperation, his dad arranged Decca’s first unlicensed boxing match. He won and became instantly hooked. Many brutal undefeated fights followed, as did two bareknuckle boxing titles. A chance meeting with renowned boxing promoter Ricky English led to Decca’s shot at the iconic ‘Guv’nor’ title. The rest, as they say, is history.



Tai Woffinden – The Autobiography

He has over 55,000 followers on Twitter, where he frequently posts pictures of himself and fiancée Faye; they married in late 2016.

With a host of titles to his name, including youngest-ever world champion (at the age of twenty-three), Woffinden has come a long way from his Scunthorpe roots. However, he has faced his share of struggles too. In 2010, while dealing with internal issues within his team, he lost his father to cancer.

Novak Djokovic: The Biography

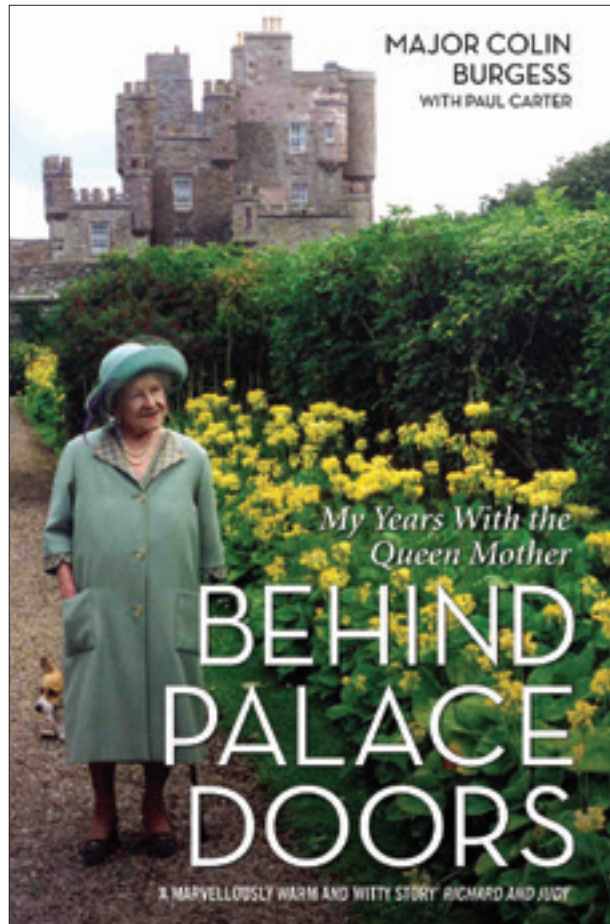
