Three Parts Dead (Craft Sequence Book 1)

A god has died, and it's up to Tara, first-year associate in the international necromantic firm of Kelethres, Albrecht, and Ao, to bring Him back to life before His city falls apart.

Her client is Kos, recently deceased fire god of the city of Alt Coulumb. Without Him, the metropolis's steam generators will shut down, its trains will cease running, and its four million citizens will riot.

Tara's job: resurrect Kos before chaos sets in. Her only help: Abelard, a chain-smoking priest of the dead god, who's having an understandable crisis of faith.

When Tara and Abelard discover that Kos was murdered, they have to make a case in Alt Coulumb's courts—and their quest for the truth endangers their partnership, their lives, and Alt Coulumb's slim hope of survival.

Set in a phenomenally built world in which justice is a collective force bestowed on a few, craftsmen fly on lightning bolts, and gargoyles can rule cities, *Three Parts Dead* introduces readers to an ethical landscape in which the line between right and wrong blurs.

Two Serpents Rise (Craft Sequence Book 2)

In *Two Serpents Rise* by Max Gladstone, shadow demons plague the city reservoir, and Red King Consolidated has sent in Caleb Altemoc—casual gambler and professional risk manager—to cleanse the water for the sixteen million people of Dresediel Lex. At the scene of the crime, Caleb finds an alluring and clever cliff runner, Crazy Mal, who easily outpaces him.

But Caleb has more than the demon infestation, Mal, or job security to worry about when he discovers that his father—the last priest of the old gods and leader of the True Quechal terrorists—has broken into his home and is wanted in connection to the attacks on the water supply.

From the beginning, Caleb and Mal are bound by lust, Craft, and chance, as both play a dangerous game where gods and people are pawns. They sleep on water, they dance in fire...and all the while the Twin Serpents slumbering beneath the earth are stirring, and they are hungry.

Full Fathom Five: (Craft Sequence Book 3)

On the island of Kavekana, Kai builds gods to order, then hands them to others to maintain. Her creations aren't conscious and lack their own wills and voices, but they accept sacrifices, and protect their worshippers from other gods—perfect vehicles for Craftsmen and Craftswomen operating in the divinely controlled Old World. When Kai sees one of her creations dying and tries to save her, she's grievously injured—then sidelined from the business entirely, her near-suicidal rescue attempt offered up as proof of her instability. But when Kai gets tired of hearing her boss, her coworkers, and her ex-boyfriend call her crazy, and starts digging into the reasons her creations die, she uncovers a conspiracy of silence and fear—which will crush her, if Kai can't stop it first.

Last First Snow: (Craft Sequence Book 4)

Forty years after the God Wars, Dresediel Lex bears the scars of liberation—especially in the Skittersill, a poor district still bound by the fallen gods' decaying edicts. As long as the gods' wards last, they strangle development; when they fail, demons will be loosed upon the city. The King in Red hires Elayne Kevarian of the Craft firm Kelethres, Albrecht, and Ao to fix the wards, but the Skittersill's people have their own ideas. A protest rises against Elayne's work, led by Temoc, a warrior-priest turned community organizer who wants to build a peaceful future for his city, his wife, and his young son.

As Elayne drags Temoc and the King in Red to the bargaining table, old wounds reopen, old gods stir in their graves, civil blood breaks to new mutiny, and profiteers circle in the desert sky. Elayne and Temoc must fight conspiracy, dark magic, and their own demons to save the peace—or failing that, to save as many people as they can.

Four Roads Cross: (Craft Sequence Book 5)

In *Four Roads Cross*, the great city of Alt Coulumb is in crisis. The moon goddess Seril, long thought dead, is back—and the people of Alt Coulumb aren't happy. Protests rock the city, and Kos Everburning's creditors attempt a hostile takeover of the fire god's church. Tara Abernathy, the god's in-house Craftswoman, must defend the church against the world's fiercest necromantic firm—and against her old classmate, a rising star in the Craftwork world.

As if that weren't enough, Cat and Raz, supporting characters from *Three Parts Dead*, are back too, fighting monster pirates; skeleton kings drink frozen cocktails, defying several principles of anatomy; jails, hospitals, and temples are broken into and out of; choirs of flame sing over Alt Coulumb; demons pose significant problems; a farmers' market proves more important to world affairs than seems likely; doctors of theology strike back; Monk-Technician Abelard performs several miracles; The Rats! play Walsh's Place; and dragons give almost-helpful counsel.

The hit-and-run death in Washington, D.C., of psychiatrist Mark Sedgwick is the opening salvo in an operation led by a rogue CIA agent and a San Francisco psychiatrist, who aim to use a psychologically programmed assassin to kill liberal presidential candidate Sen. George Mortinson. Dr. Nicolas Tatum, who teaches a seminar on evaluating human behavior at George Washington Law School, fingers one of Sedgwick's patients as the programmed assassin, to his peril. This thriller starts off inside the mind of a contract killer—crude, sexist, sadistic. And it gets even better. Harvey has put together a grand whopper of a thriller, with Manhattan and Hollywood settings, glamorous people, slimy financial dealings, and craftily paced suspense. Mongo the murderer is commissioned to kill gorgeous superstar Catherine Delure. She's heavily guarded. How does he do it? It involves a tape recorder. Jeb Barker, the cop on his trail, is blessedly free of noirish cynicism—he just does his job. The stalker learns he's being stalked and decides to make Jeb his next victim. Their cat-and-cat game is played out in crime labs and Malibu pool parties, and the author cranks up the tension while letting readers think they know who's behind the killing. They likely won't. The author works in a pared-down, pulsating style and introduces nicely timed humor, as when Mongo tries to renegotiate his fees. The ending is self-consciously Hollywood hokum, but that's fine. That's the real world now.

A cleverly executed hybrid, this feel-good thriller drops an unlikely hero, an inept but super-straight accountant-on-the-skids, into the thick of the New York City drug culture. Unemployed widower Michael Goodman, on a last-ditch job hunt in Florida, stumbles onto a cache of ultra-pure heroin in a rental car mix-up caused by a Latin drug dealer's hangover. Desperate for cash for his six-year-old daughter's serious medical problems, Michael evades druglords and K-9 sniffers and whisks the dope back to his Manhattan walkup—where his adventures really begin. A bungled mugging by a black teen in serious withdrawal begives Michael a chance to contact a local dealer. The dealer, Big Red, sets up a "sample buy" at midnight but stiffes Michael, stealing the drug sample, his pants, shoes and wallet. Later, he rescues an abused woman, Carmen Cruz, who, after romance ensues, arranges for Michael to meet her brother, who has Mafia ties to the drug world. Soon word of the pure heroin has spread to the NYPD and the DEA through their snitches, among whom are Michael's teen contact and Big Red himself. Goodman ends up the focus of a drug sting, the game in a druglord revenge hunt and a target of Big Red's greed. These forces trip over themselves while Goodman, ever the innocent, goes calmly forward with his plan to get enough money to take care of his daughter. Criminal defense attorney and ex-narcotics agent Klempner (*Felony Murder*) knows this world well. His magic lies in preserving the purity of a true innocent amid the evils of the drug world, thus creating a study in contrast that will satisfy thrill seekers, especially those who still believe in happy endings. 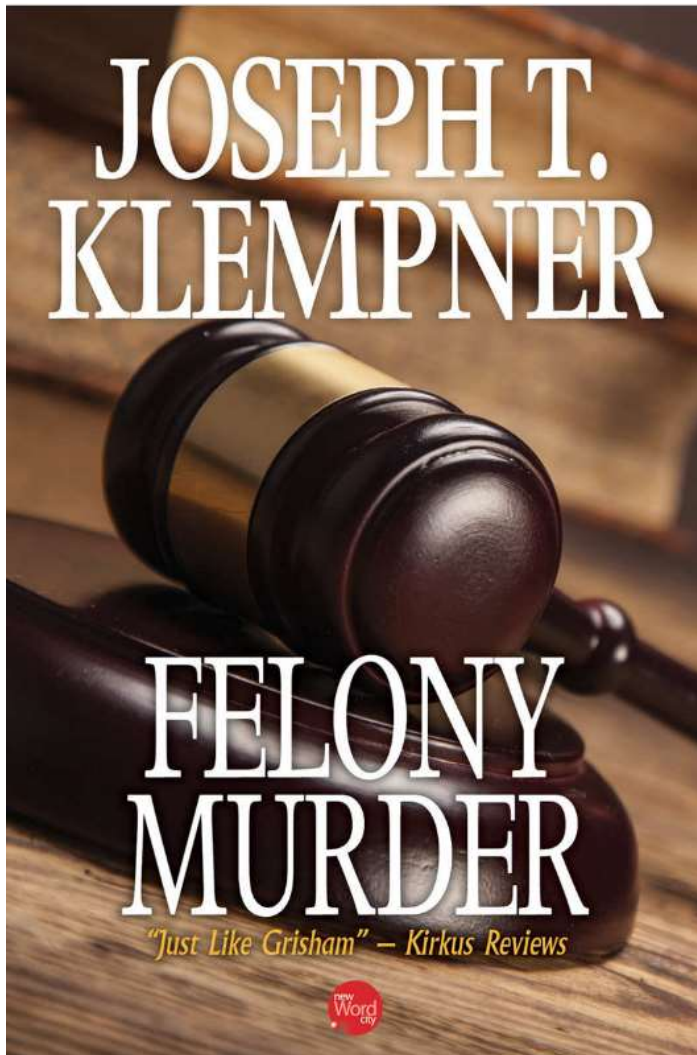

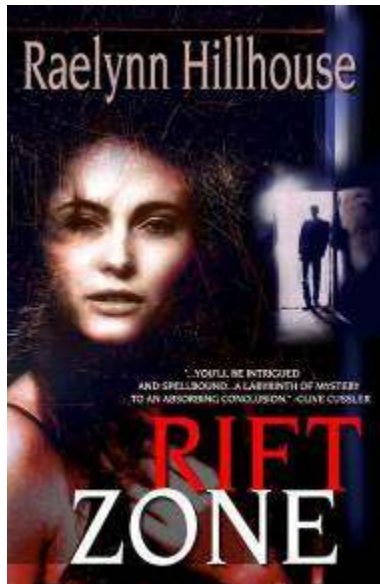

Hillhouse's gripping debut, a cold war thriller, has so many unexpected pleasures that its flaws barely register. It's 1989, and American professor Faith Whitney is staying in Germany with the faint (and dimming) hope of learning about her missing father; to make a living, she smuggles minor items (Stalin china, Nazi crystal, etc.) from East Berlin to West. After being captured by the East German Stasi, Faith is forced to smuggle for them or face imprisonment. KGB agent Zara Bogdanov is another antagonist, but a sympathetic one: ambitious and beautiful, she's also openly gay, a strike against her advancement. Capturing Faith and getting her to spy for the KGB would be a feather in Zara's cap, but her motives are unclear, even to herself. Their extended cat-and-mouse game, fueled by a flirty mutual attraction (though Faith is straight), gives an enticing pulse to the sometimes implausible plot. An extended section in which Faith transports hazardous material feels like a climax, but the story continues for another 50-odd pages. The book may be better for its two strong women and its incisive picture of a significant era in recent history than for its thriller elements, but Hillhouse is a welcome new voice. *Agent*, Bob Diforio. (Aug.)

Buck, with Jon Land and Lindsay Preston, presents a well-researched and smoothly written account of an undercover drug investigation into the Canadian Hells Angels and their use of a New York Indian reservation. The book spans 14 years and proceeds chronologically from a domestic assault case in rural Ohio that leads to a multimillion-dollar drug conspiracy. Buck, a former municipal undercover officer, details how he infiltrated the operation via surveillance and informants, giving his unvarnished views on the legalization of marijuana, federal drug policy, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), and undercover work along the way. What helps the volume is a "line-up" section at the outset listing the nearly 50 participants, along with photos, maps, and an "aftermath" addendum describing the results. Readers should expect a novelistic treatment of the case, with reconstructed dialog and descriptions of the participants' inner thoughts. This structure works owing to the authors' extensive research; the facts of the case can be confirmed through news accounts. Another novelistic approach by a former police officer detached to the DEA is Timothy C. Richards's *Dope Is a D.E.A.'d Man's Game*. **VERDICT Recommended for true crime aficionados seeking valuable insight into undercover drug operations.** —HARRY CHARLES, ST. LOUIS

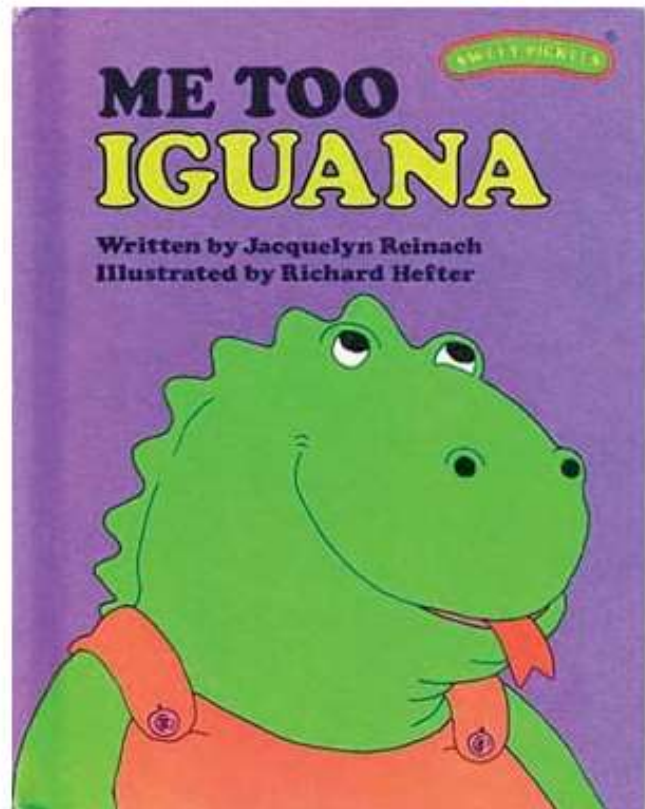
Created by Jacquelyn Reinach, Richard Heffer and Ruth Lerner Perle, the "Sweet Pickles" collection numbers 40 books and has sold more than 50 million copies. Bento is eyeing TV adaptations of the books' characters and stories, as well as merchandising options and a re-launch of the series on a digital platform.

Headed by former Film Roman prexy/chief operating officer Scott Greenberg, and "The Simpsons" vets Joel Kuwahara and Mark McJimsey, Bento licensed the books from Euphrosyne Inc., of which Heffer is president.

In addition to "Bob's Burgers," which premiered in January and has been renewed by Fox for the 2011-12 TV season, Bento is co-producing animated "Allen Gregory" with 20th Television, Chernin Entertainment (Peter Chernin and Katherine Pope) and series star Jonah Hill for Fox, which has ordered seven episodes.

David A. Goodman, Jarrad Paul and Andrew Mogel are also exec producers of the project, about a 7-year-old genius forced into an elementary school class with kids his own age.

Bento also co-produced TBS' "Neighbors From Hell."
