


Peppino Impastato was born in Sicily into a mafia family. He lived not far from the home of Gaetano Badalamenti, one of the bosses of Cosa Nostra, but that doesn't stop him from rebelling. In a period in which speaking out meant risking your life, Peppino sets up a free radio station on which he denounces the crimes he witnesses every day. And furthermore, at a time in which the mafia was based on instilling terror, he dared to make fun of the bosses and to deride them. This is an unpardonable fault for which he will pay with his life and at the age of just thirty, he was killed. But his sacrifice was meant to encourage others to rebel and his name has entered for ever the annals of Heroes.

The true story of Oskar Schindler, a Nazi who saved hundreds of Jews. He lived in Cracow during the second world war and gave refuge in his factory to hundreds of Jews. He was a member of the Nazi party but he loved life and beauty and conquered the dark heart of evil only to crush it. He became friends with the most high-ranking members of the SS and bribed them with luxury goods in order to buy the lives of his Jewish workers. He gained the trust of the murderous head of the Plaszow concentration camp and handed over to him a list of IIOO Jews who were to be saved from the gas chambers.
