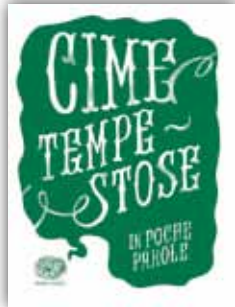
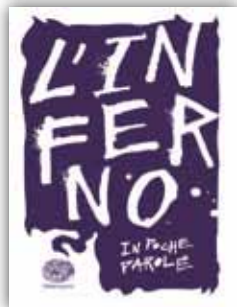
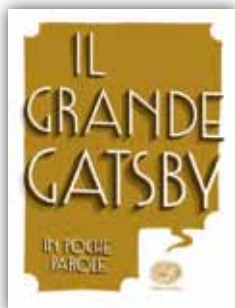
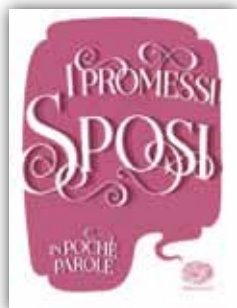


Donata Turlo FROM ONE TO INFINITY

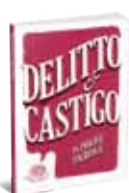

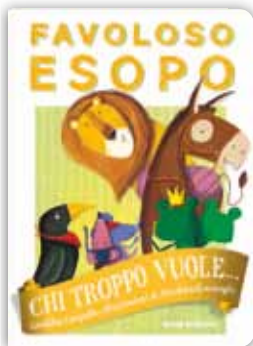
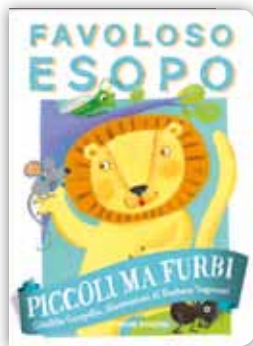
