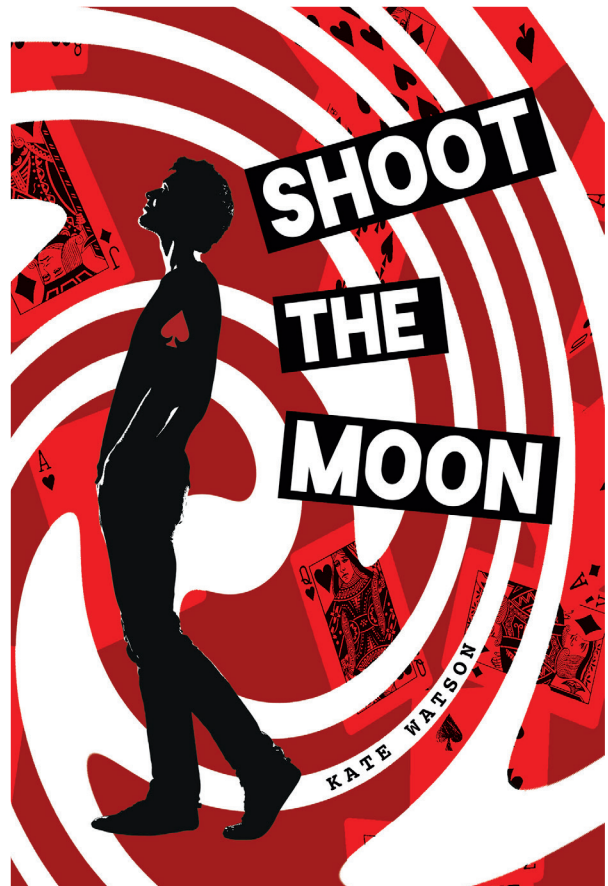
SHOOT THE MOON

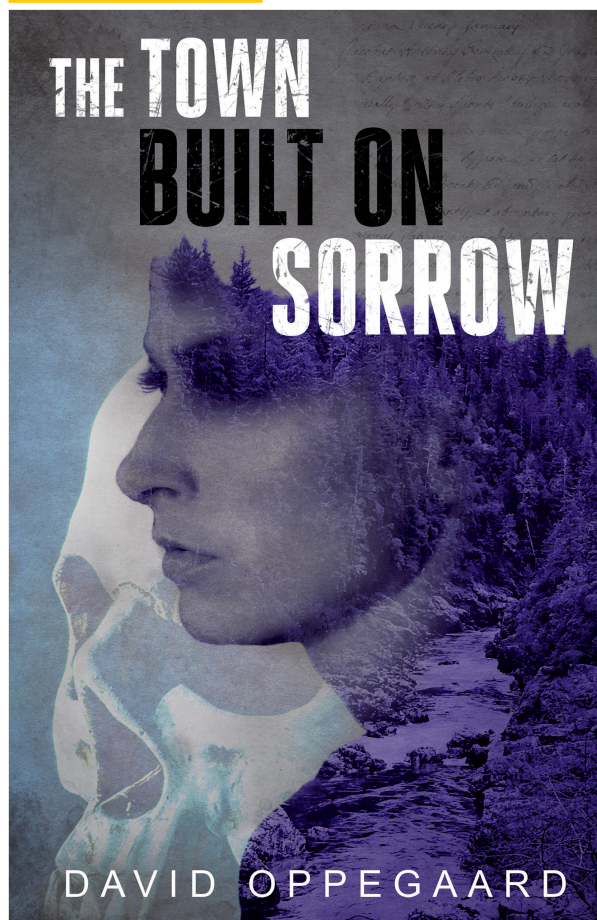


THE TOWN BUILT ON SORROW
