Meet the Wonder-*full* Aleca Zamm, a normal nine-year-old with an extraordinary ability: she can stop time!



Before, Isaak lived the life of the average American teenager. But on the eve of his eighteenth birthday, a dormant force awakens within him.


Moments before a fleet of men with strange, powerful weapons invade his home, Isaak flees into the night, led by a mysterious girl with an iridescent birthmark.


