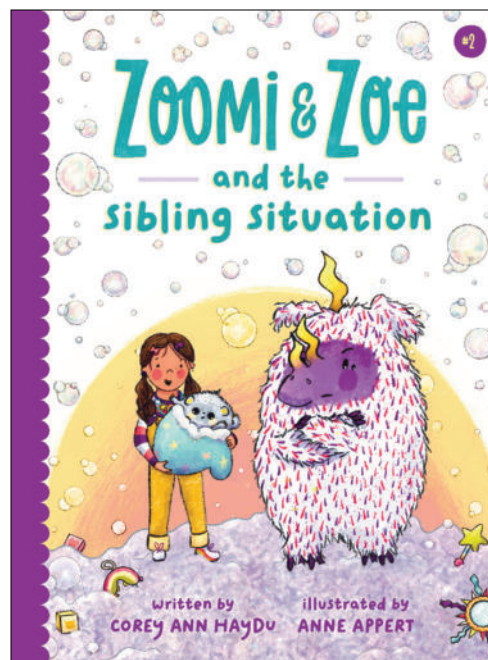


Zoomi and Zoe and the Tricky Turnaround
